Raé Miller is an American abstract artist who moved to San Miguel de Allende, Mexico, in 2007. She paints in her studio at the Fabrica La Aurora.

Raé's fascination with light has been a recurring theme in her work, where she uses translucent layering to capture and express it. Raé's paintings and monotypes have been shown internationally in galleries and public installations.

Raé was selected as one of the artists for the new Rosewood Mayakobá in Playa del Carmen, and another resort project in Cabo San Lucas. She was a board member of Indian Valley Artists, the group who laid the groundwork for the Marin Museum of Contemporary Art in Novato, California.
